The popular salon closed for repair and renovations, but now it's back and better than ever at the same location (15-17 S. Moger Ave.; Mt. Kisco; 242-1700; www.richardscottsalon.com).

Flat-panel TVs have been strategically placed throughout the salon, including the newly expanded nails department, which now includes a fourth pedicure chair and a courtesy phone. A spacious lounge outfitted with plush chairs is perfect for sipping a complimentary cup of coffee, tea, or cappuccino, before or after haircuts and color. The Hair Replacement Center and Kathryn Ellen Makeup Studio continue to operate in sleekly refurbished new digs. Meanwhile, the spa—which sustained the most damage—has been completely revamped under the direction of owners Tamara Weinstein and Julianne Foley. It now has its own private reception area (saving those with spa appointments from schlepping through the noisy hair salon to check in and out) and a couples' massage room. In addition, there are now two sunless-tanning possibilities: A body-bronzing treatment (\$60) that includes exfoliation, hydration, and application of the self-tanning lotion, and a new "Mystic" spray-on tanning Day booth (\$30–\$35). Each is expected to last four to five days and is perfect for sustaining that end-of-summer glow.
